SHARE Update

Year-End Review in Aspen

Aspen has a feature called Year-End Review available to show patrons their circulation habits over the last calendar year. Patrons with reading history enabled will be able to see a personalized slideshow that summarizes reading habits such as favorite authors, top series, and reading recommendations.

New Local Subject Heading: Playaway WhaZoodle!

Playaway has a new audio format product called WhaZoodle! SHARE staff recommend a local subject heading be created for WhaZoodles! to allow patrons to find such items easily in the catalog. **Bobbi Perrymen motioned, and Gwen Bumpers seconded to add Playaway WhaZoodle! as a local subject heading. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.**

Unfinished Business

AI Policy/Procedure

The SHARE Training Cataloger presented the AI Policy/Procedure document. The committee discussed the need for a policy that outlines identifying AI materials when possible. Procedurally, PCC guidance on AI-generated materials states to indicate the specific AI bot used during creation when indicated, and SHARE would request that catalogers indicate a material is AI-generated using appropriate 655 fields in the record as a local edit. A future SHARE Cataloger's Training Session could be used to guide members on how to identify AI materials when purchasing or cataloging. **Bobbi Perryman motioned, and Chrissy Bellizzi seconded to send the AI/Computer-Generated Material Policy out for member comment.
