### **Current Fee Structure:**

# BASE FEE (\$250.00) + POPULATION FEE + 0.5% OF LIBRARY'S COLLECTION BUDGET = ANNUAL CLOUD LIBRARY FEE

Libraries with a service population of less than 1,000 only pay the base fee

- Requires member libraries to self-report data every other year to determine fees
- The collection budget portion requires member libraries to include all portions of their collection budget, including those collection items not included in Polaris

# Option 1:

BASE FEE (\$250.00) + POPULATION FEE (using higher scale noted below) = Annual Cloud Library Fee

Population Served	Population Fee
Less than 1,000*	\$0 Libraries serving populations less than 1,000 pay <i>only</i> the \$250 base fee (no population or collection budget component)
1,000 - 2,999	\$150
3,000 – 4,999	\$200
5,000 – 9,999	\$250
10,000 – 19,999	\$400
20,000 – 29,000	\$750
>30,000	\$1300

Libraries with a service population of less than 1,000 only pay the base fee

- Population data can be pulled from IPLAR reports by SHARE staff
- Removes collection budget portion from fee structure
- Changes in fees vary widely by percentage. The largest increase is at 66% or the largest decrease is at -63%. Doesn't take into account tax revenue.

## Option 2:

### BASE FEE + REVENUE/ENROLLMENT SCALE (see below) = Annual Cloud Library Fee

School/academic libraries with an FTE (students) < than 999 OR public libraries with a revenue < than \$20,000 only pay the base fee (\$250.00)

- Revenue/Enrollment data can be pulled from IPLAR reports by SHARE staff
- Cloud Library renewal agreements could be sent at the same time as SHARE Annual Agreements because they both depend on the same data
- Changes in fees vary less widely than in Option 1
- In this scenario, member libraries that would see an increase in their annual fee typically have higher annual revenues, while libraries that would see a decrease typically have lower annual revenues
