# Definition

General or specialized information relating to a work.

# Some notes about notes

- Can come from anywhere on the item, or from an outside source
- Some notes may be used with any format; some are specific to certain formats
- Some notes use standard wording (LC practice); some are free-text or quoted
- AACR and RDA guidelines are the same, except regarding order of notes

# MARC coding and ISBD punctuation

- MARC tags for notes – 5XX
- Some note fields use indicators; some do not
  - ◆ Indicators generate labels in the PAC
- Some note fields use only 1 or 2 subfields; some use many
- Most notes end in a period (.); some do not use ending punctuation (tags 510, 516, 536, and 586)

# Order of notes

- **AACR**
  - ◆ Order of notes in a record is based on importance of information for that format, not MARC tag number
- **RDA**
  - ◆ Does not prescribe an order of notes
- **OCLC**
  - ◆ Records are saved with notes in order entered by the cataloger
  - ◆ SHARE practice: do not edit order of notes in OCLC master records
- **Polaris**
  - ◆ Records are saved with notes in numerical order

# MARC tag 500 (general note)—some uses

- **Nature, scope, or form**
  - ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aCompact disc.
- **Edition and history**
  - ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aBased on the novel by Lee Child.
- **Information about accompanying material**
  - ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aAccompanying CD-ROM includes practice test questions.
  - ◆ Remember to code *Accompanying matter* fixed field if appropriate
- **Index**
  - ◆ Use MARC tag 500 if there is an index and no bibliographical references.  
Combine in MARC tag 504 if bibliographic references are present (see slide 10)
  - ◆ Remember to code *Index* fixed field
  - ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aIncludes index.

# MARC tag 500 (general note)—some uses (cont.)

## ■ Source of title

- ◆ **AACR**—use when title is not taken from chief source of information

- ◆ **RDA**—not required—title can come from any source on the item

- ◆ Examples:

- ☞ No title page, but there is a title on the cover, spine, and table of contents page. The cataloger chose to use the title on the cover:

- 500 \_\_ \_ \$aTitle from cover.

- ☞ No title page, but there is a title on the cover (no other titles)

- 500 \_\_ \_ \$aCover title.

- ☞ Videorecording—title is taken from the case rather than the title frames:

- 500 \_\_ \_ \$aTitle from container.

# MARC tag 500 (general note)—some uses (cont.)

## ■ **Special features (videorecordings)**

- ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aSpecial features include “making of” featurette, director’s commentary, interviews with cast and crew.

## ■ **Other information**

- ◆ Use this tag for information to be noted, but that doesn’t fit a more specific note
- ◆ 500 \_\_ \$aIncludes discussion questions (p. 50-55).

# Quoted notes

- Usually (but not always) in MARC tag 500
- Transcribe exactly from the source
- Enclose in quotation marks
- Indicate source of note\*
  - ◆ If quoted from chief source of information, place ending punctuation inside quotes
    - ☞ 500 \_\_ \_ \$a“Based on a true story.”
  - ◆ If quoted from another source, follow quotes by two dashes, provide source of quote, and end in a period. First word of source is capitalized
    - ☞ 500 \_\_ \_ \$a“Based on a true story”—Cover.
- \*SHARE best practice: Do not need to indicate source of info in MARC tag 520 (Summary note)

# Some commonly used notes

## ■ 504 – Bibliography, etc.

- ◆ If item also has an index, note that here instead of in MARC tag 500
- ◆ Include page numbers of bibliographical references if they are in one sequence
- ◆ Code fixed fields *Cont* and *Index* as appropriate
- ◆ 504 \_\_ \$aIncludes bibliographical references (p. 245-249) and index.

## ■ 505 – Formatted contents note

- ◆ Use appropriate 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> indicators
- ◆ See SHARE best practice for guidance
- ◆ Basic contents note
  - ☞ 505 0\_ \$aA house divided cannot stand -- A more perfect union -- Dawn of a new century -- Rolling into the fifties -- Tear down this wall -- Timeline -- Republican presidents.
- ◆ Enhanced contents note
  - ☞ 505 00 \$tStudy in scarlet /\$rArthur Conan Doyle --\$tThe purloined letter /\$rEdgar Allan Poe -- \$tThe mirror crack'd from side to side /\$rAgatha Christie.

# Some commonly used notes—cont.

- **508 – Creation/production credits**
  - ◆ Videorecordings and sound recordings—use for functions not listed in the statement of responsibility (245 subfield c)
  - ◆ 508 \_\_ \$aDirector of photography, Michael Coulter ; editor, Nick Moore ; music, Craig Armstrong ; costume designer, Joanna Johnston ; production designer, Jim Clay.
- **511 – Participant/performer (use appropriate indicator)**
  - ◆ 511 1 \_ \$aLiam Neeson, Emma Thompson, Hugh Grant, Alan Rickman, Laura Linney.
  - ◆ Indicator generates a label in the PAC
- **518 – Date/time and place of event**
  - ◆ 518 \_\_ \$aRecorded live at Carnegie Hall on March 10, 2012.
- **520 – Summary, etc.**
  - ◆ Use 1<sup>st</sup> indicator 4 to generate label *Content advice* in the PAC
  - ◆ 520 4 \_ \$aContains strong language and graphic images.
  - ◆ Use without indicators to enter general summary info (see SHARE best practice for guidance)

# Some commonly used notes—cont.

- **521 – Target audience** (use appropriate indicator)
  - ◆ 521 0 \_ \$a3.1.
  - ◆ Indicator generates a label in the PAC
- **538 – System requirements**
  - ◆ 538 \_ \_ \$aDVD; region A; widescreen; aspect ratio 1,85:1; double-sided.
- **546 – Language** (Information about language of text, sound track, subtitles, etc. Free text of coded info in 041 and/or fixed field Lang)
  - ◆ 546 \_ \_ \$aSound tracks in English, French, and Portuguese with optional subtitles in Spanish, Greek, and Tagalog; closed-captioned.
- **588 – Source of description** (used in serial records)
  - ◆ 588 \_ \_ \$aDescription based on: Spring 2000.
    - ☞ May be combined with a source of title note
  - ◆ 588 \_ \_ \$aLatest issue consulted: Winter 2014.

# Less commonly used notes—cont.

## ■ 502 – Dissertations

- ◆ 502\_\_ \$aThesis (M. Eng.)--University of Louisville, 2013.
- ◆ All info may be included in subfield a or split into other subfields

## ■ 533 – Reproduction

- ◆ 533\_\_ \$aPhotocopy.\$bSeattle, Wash. :\$cUniversity of Washington,\$d1979.\$e28 cm.

## ■ 536 – Funded by or issued by

- ◆ 536\_\_ \$aFunded by a grant from the Fine Arts Foundation

## ■ 586 -- Awards

- ◆ 586\_\_ \$aCaldecott Medal, 2012

# Local notes

- MARC tag 590 or 599
- In SHARE, used only in ALPLM records, in MARC tag 599
- Delete local notes in other records
