



Using the SHARE Catalog to Borrow Cloud Library eBooks



- 1) Download the app for your device and log into your library account. Visit yourcloudlibrary.com to find out where to download the app.

Mobile Devices:

- 2) Log in by selecting *Illinois Heartland Library System* as your library and entering your library card number and pin.

- 3) Browse the collection, check out a book, or place a hold.

Log in to the SHARE catalog from your library's website, or visit www.illshareit.com to find your library.

- To browse Cloud Library titles in the SHARE catalog do a keyword search for "Cloud" and limit the format to "Ebook" or "Audio Ebook".
- Find a title you would like to Check Out and click on the "Check Out" button to the right.
