- *FTE=full-time enrollment or full-time employees (specials)*
- *Member libraries that see an increase in their annual fee typically have higher annual revenues, while libraries that would see a decrease typically have lower annual revenues*

**For Current cloudLibrary Fee Structure**

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**Current Fee Structure:**

$$\text{BASE FEE } (\$250.00) + \text{POPULATION FEE} + 0.5\% \text{ OF LIBRARY'S COLLECTION BUDGET} = \text{Annual cloudLibrary Fee}$$

Libraries with a service population of less than 1,000 only pay the base fee

Population Served	Population Fee
<b>Less than 1,000*</b>	\$0 Libraries serving populations less than 1,000 pay <i>only</i> the \$250 base fee (no population or collection budget component)
<b>1,000-9,999</b>	\$100
<b>10,000-19,999</b>	\$200
<b>20,000-29,999</b>	\$300
<b>30,000-39,999</b>	\$400
<b>40,000-49,999</b>	\$500
<b>50,000-59,999</b>	\$600
<b>60,000-69,999</b>	\$700
<b>70,000-79,999</b>	\$800
<b>80,000-89,999</b>	\$900
<b>90,000 and over</b>	\$1,000

- *The collection budget portion requires member libraries to include all portions of their collection budget, including those collection items not included in Polaris*
